



This letter contains all the information for the Babyshoot that I will come to your home to do.

- We have contact first, usually by e-mail. Here we discuss how old your child is at that time and what size he or she is wearing.
 - Then we agree on a date for the shoot and the time, trying to avoid the naps.
 - In total, the shoot takes about 1,5 hour.
 - To have a quiet and safe environment for the child and the shoot it is important that no others (children, family, etc.) are present around the shoot. So don't schedule appointments when I come!
 - It is important that the father (or other assistant) remains present during the shoot. This because of carrying stuff, but also to assist during the shoot for safety reasons.
 - I ignore the child upon arrival so that it can get used to it.
 - I may ask one of you to sit behind me for the attention from the child.
 - You can help me by keeping one or two of the favorite toys with you.
 - I have nice things and clothes that I will bring with me.
 - If everything goes well, we'll do three changes, but sometimes less if the baby needs it.
 - I prefer a room with Northern Lights where I can set up my set. Before the shoot I will determine where to work.
 - It is allowed to make one backstage picture. Keep taking picture is strictly prohibited.
 - Preheat the house! Around 23 degrees is perfect. I'll also bring a little heater to help me.
 - You will receive the photos within 2 weeks after the appointment.
 - You will receive a gallery of 20 pictures to choose from, according to the package you've chosen. An upgrade is always possible.
